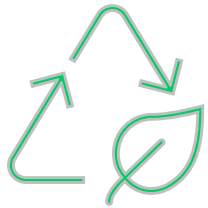




# Port Saint John Community Liaison Committee

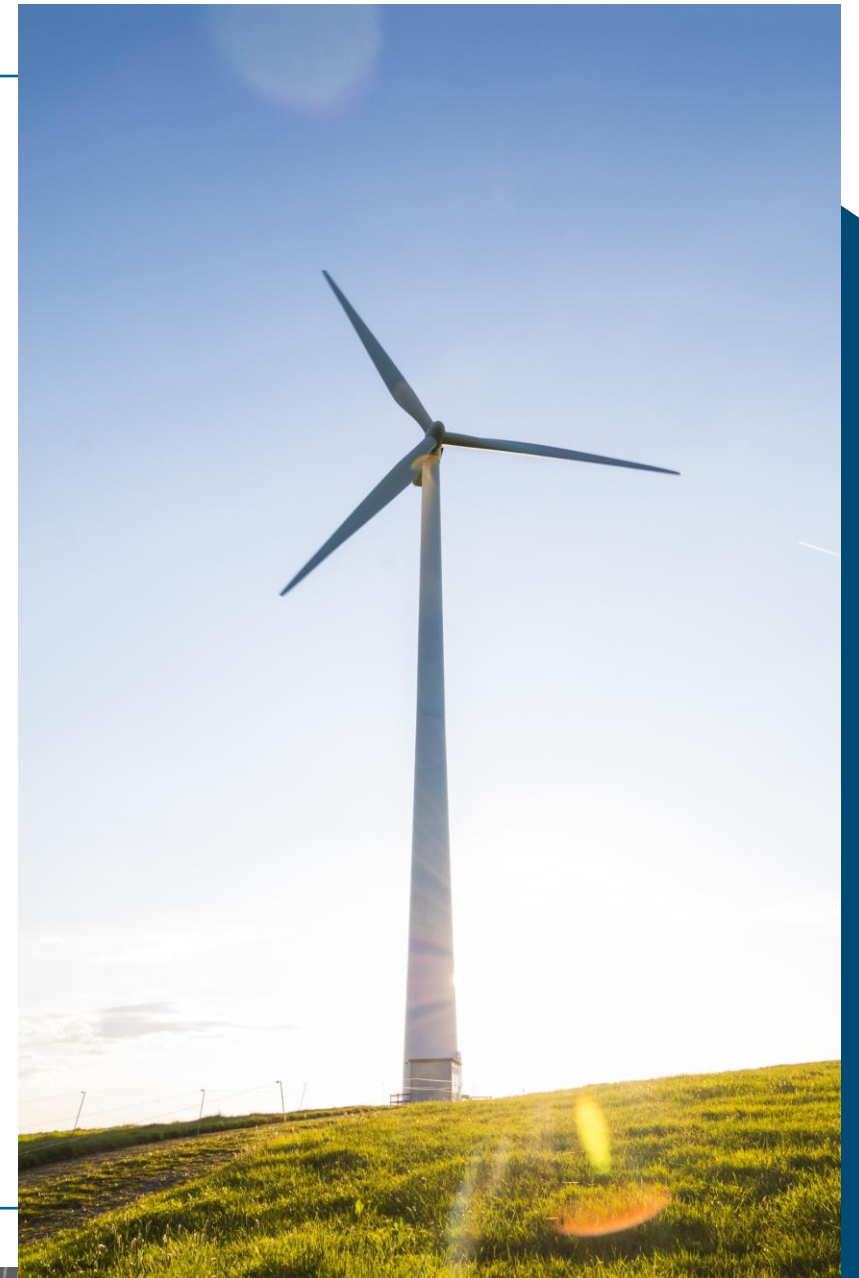

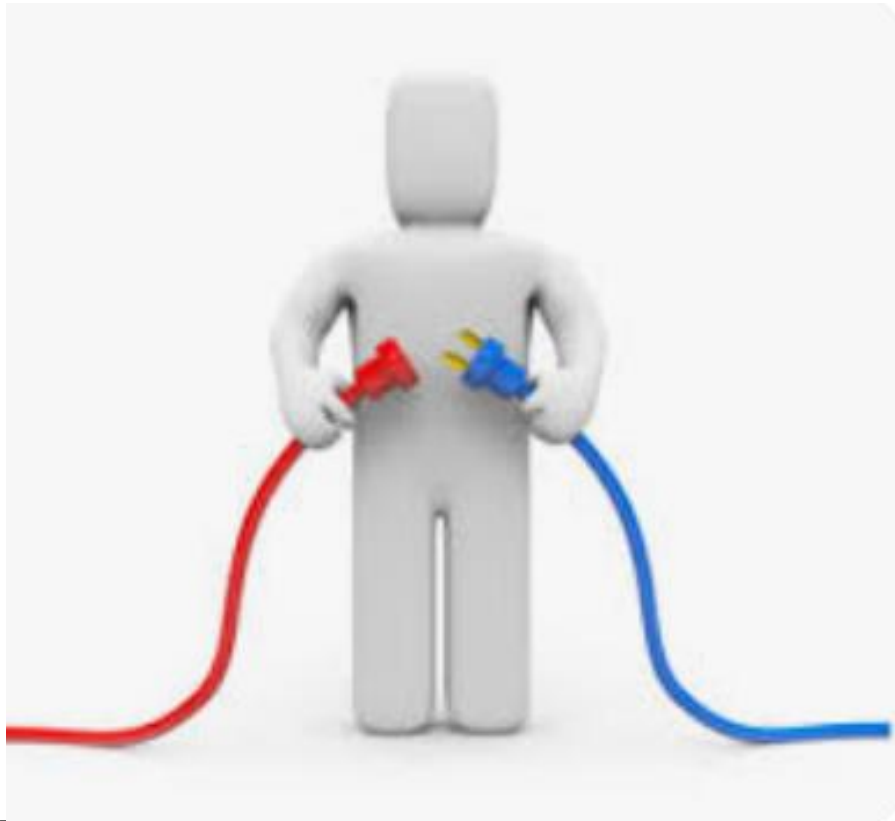

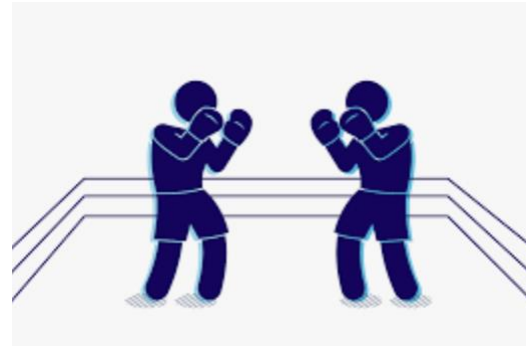
