

Community Grants: Impact achieved to date

- We use the Business for Societal Impact (B4SI) methodology to measure the impact of our grants program. At its heart, the B4SI Framework is a simple input output model, enabling any social impact activity to be assessed consistently in terms of the resources committed and the results achieved. It breaks down the elements of the activity into: the inputs (what’s contributed?), the outputs (what happens?) and, ultimately, the impacts achieved (what changes?).
- Since its launch in 2021, our Community Grants have achieved the following:
