

# Intermodal transport and Port Authority

- Port Authorities do not handle cargo or decide on modality
- Port Authorities can influence:
  - Feasibility studies
  - Subsidies
  - Pilot projects
  - Promotion of intermodal transport
  - Lease contracts
  - Intermodal infrastructure in port area and lobby national infrastructure
  - What else???
- Dry / liquid bulk => providing the right infrastructure
- Containers / general cargo => providing the right infrastructure and intermodal development
- In close cooperation with market (terminal operators, shippers, industry, logistic service profiders)

### Role of port authorities in intermodal transport?"

- Important, greater role, independent coordinator different parties, crisis give new chances
- Pricing policy, but competition
- USA: rules / bye-laws, Emission Control Areas in sensitive locations, facilitate localised clean energy production, cargo equipment movers to burn bio-fuel, strict regimes all vehicles entering port area to minimise 'bad' emissions
- Bring about the (im)possibilities of multimodality to all companies / relations using the port area.
- Facilitating 'open source' terminal facilities.
- Intermodal can influence quick decision new infrastructure



#### Betuweroute




- Keyrail commercial exploitation of the Betuweroute
- Maintenance, Capacity management and Traffic control
- 50% Prorail, 35% Port of Rotterdam,
   15% Port of Amsterdam

#### Super fast ferry






- 35 Knots (65 km/h versus 70 by road)
- Punctuality, reliability and safety
- Between France (Bologne sur Mer) and England (Dover)

#### All Weather Terminal



- up to 7500 tons under all weather conditions (indoors, short sea, rail and barge)
- 3 covered berth (80 meters and 100 meters)
- 3 overhead cranes are used, lifting capacity 40 tons each

### Organizational innovation

- Organize a regional Logistics
   Platform (co-ordination cargo owners, industries and logistic service providers)
- Integrated door to door intermodal concepts
- Independent integrated intermodal booking agency

#### Lessons learned

- Intermodal accessibility is of strategic importance for a port
- Focus from just the sea side also to the hinterlandside
- But Port Authority does not handle cargo, operates terminals or ships or trains!
- Projects are PPS, need involvement of industry and logistic service providers
