

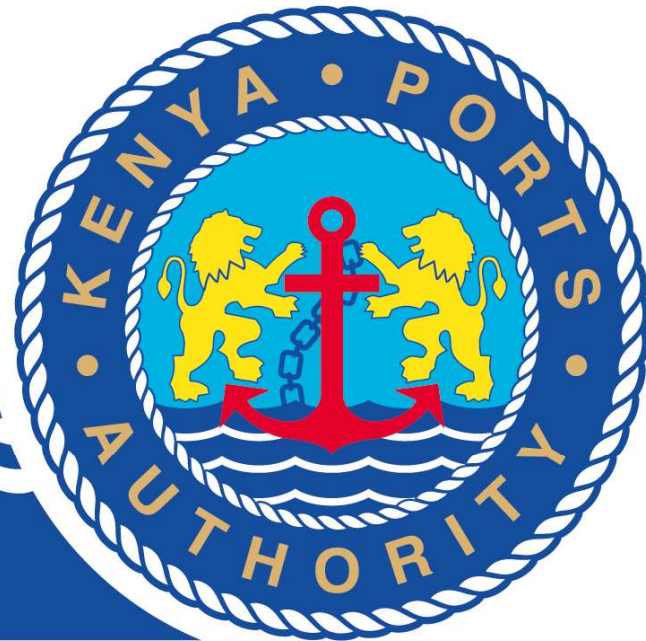

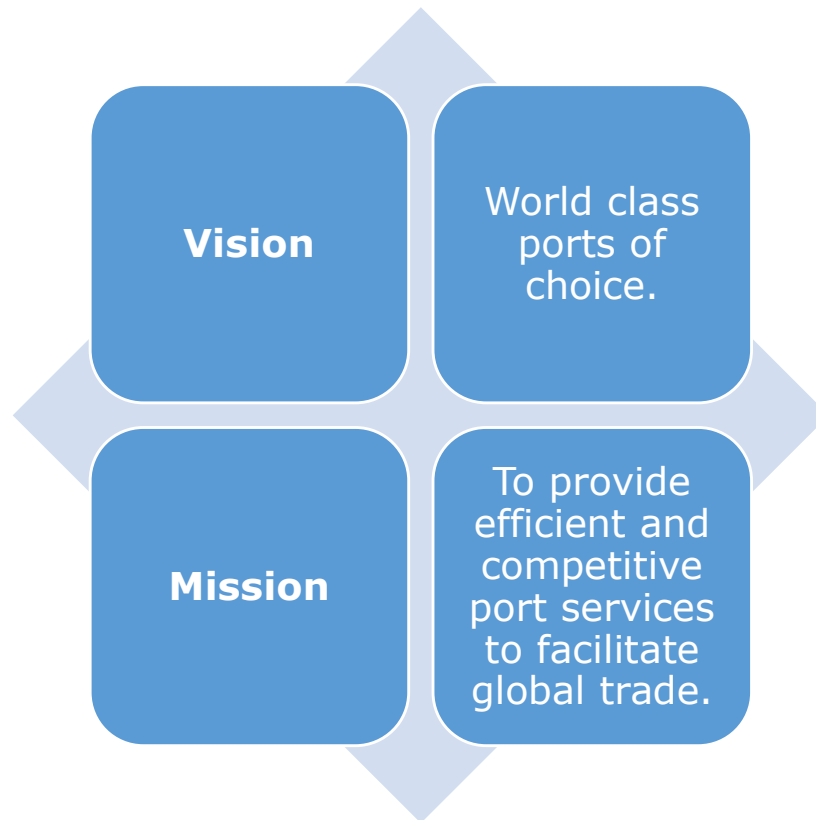

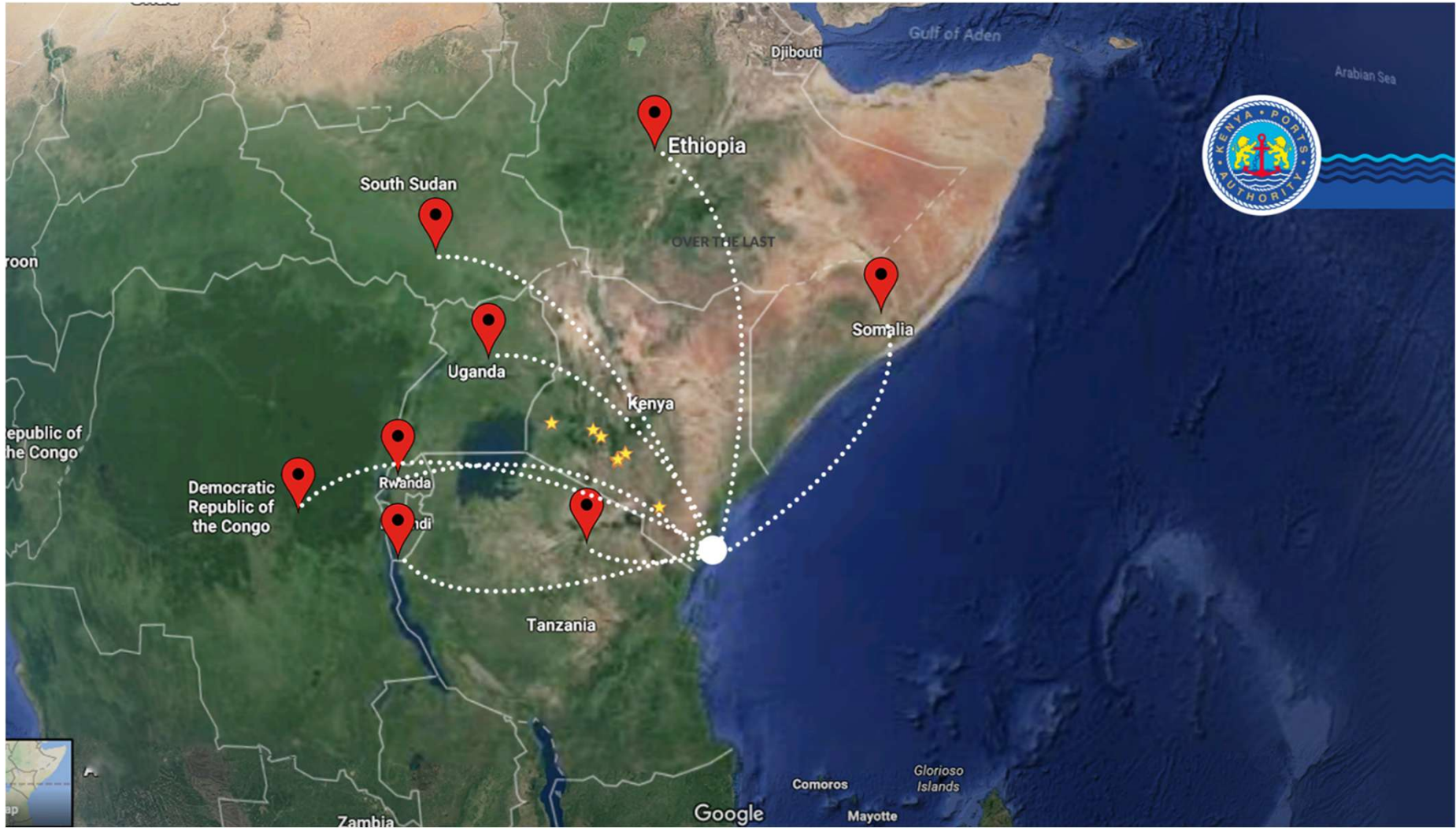

- ❑ The Port of Mombasa is the key entry and exit point for cargo into and out of - Kenya, **Uganda**, Rwanda, Burundi, **DRC**, Tanzania, **South Sudan** and Ethiopia.
- ❑ The Port is extended further inland to the ICD Nairobi & ICD Naivasha. We have Kisumu ICD and Kisumu Pier that are operational but not connected by rail. Deliveries to Malaba are via the MGR. The objectives for these extended facilities are to: -
 - Extend port services closer to inland customers
 - Ease inland transport challenges & costs
 - Reduce container dwell time at the port
 - Minimize road damage and carnage
 - Provide security and safety of cargo (use rail)
- ❑ The Port transactions are accessed by the Regional Revenue Authorities, authorized Shipping Lines or their Agents, Clearing & Forwarding Agents, Container Freight Stations and Trucking Companies who all seek registration to be able to participate in the Cargo delivery process

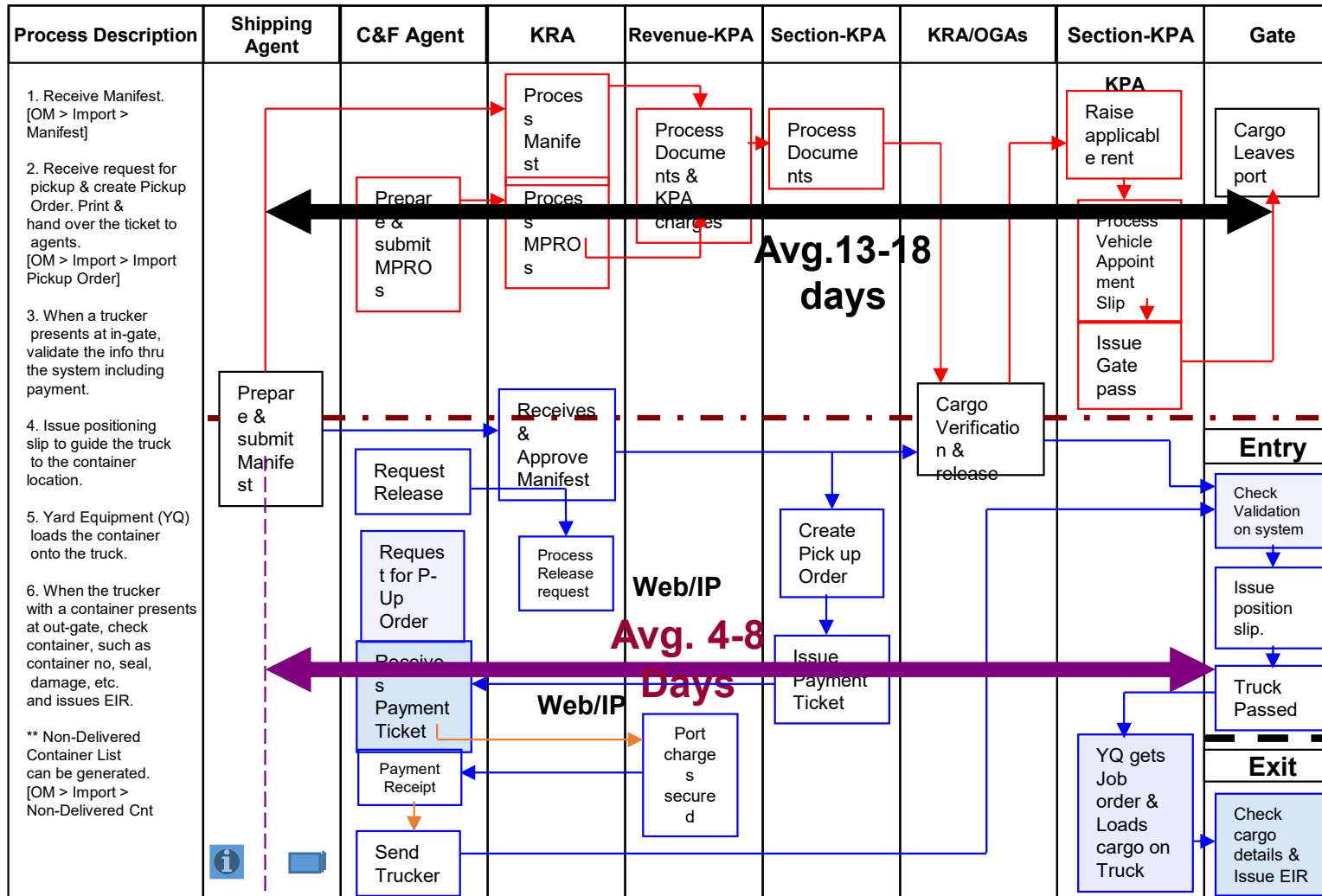




- ❑ The Single Customs Territory (SCT July 2014) adopted the Destination Model of clearance of goods with assessment & collection of revenue at the 1st point of entry and in the destination Partner States
- ❑ Process covers clearance of Maritime & Intra Regional Cargo (Imports, Exports) to & from EAC Partner States together with Transshipment
- ❑ SCT is premised on the following pillars: -
 - ❑ Free circulation of goods;
 - ❑ Address non-tariff barriers & delays;
 - ❑ Efficiency along major trade corridors;
- ❑ Scope
 - ❑ imported goods into the EAC
 - ❑ export of goods from Partner States to markets outside the EAC
 - ❑ intra-EAC transfer of goods
 - ❑ Port and Border Operations and trade facilitation

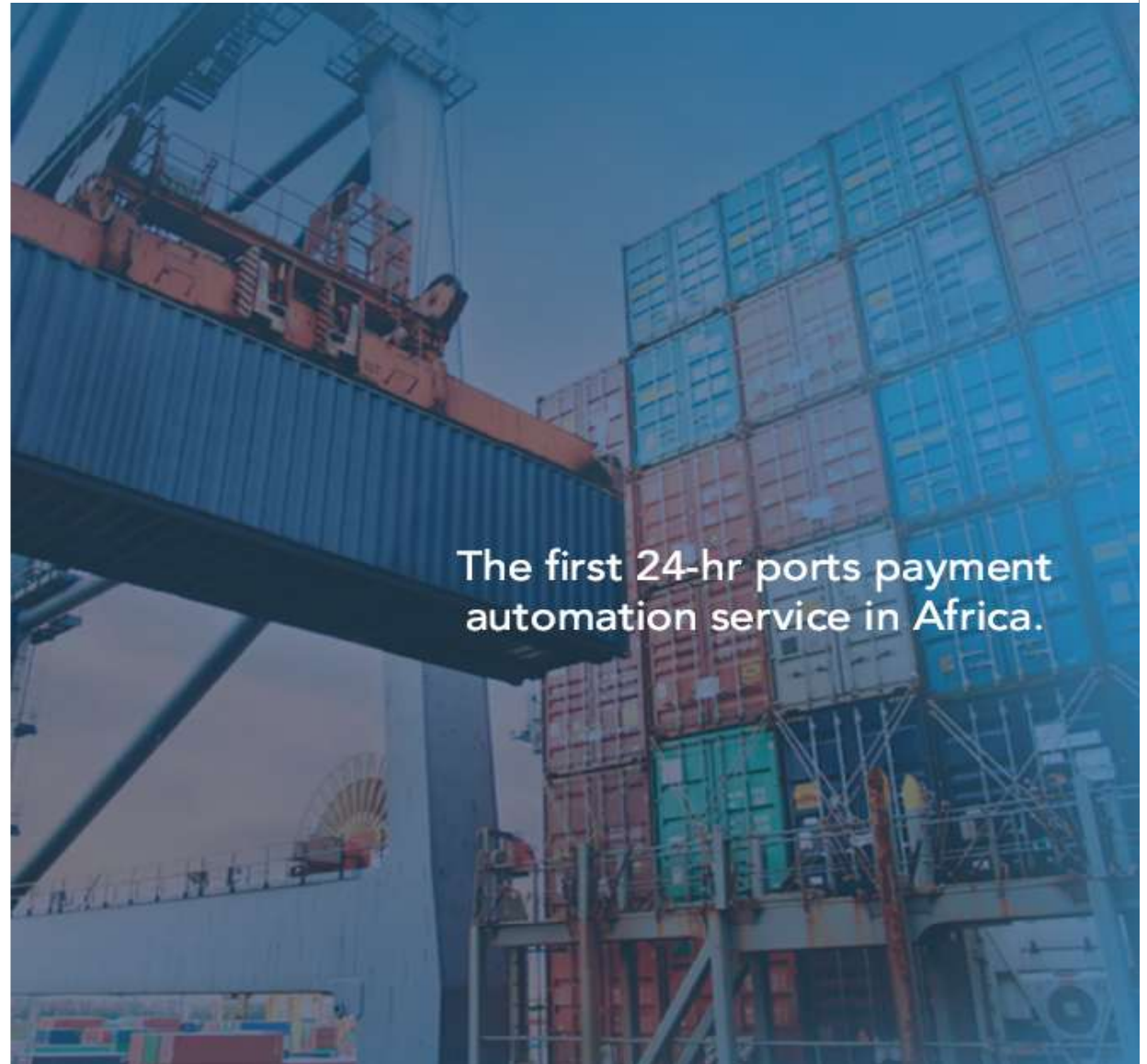

The first 24-hr ports payment automation service in Africa.

Inception

- ❑ Mid June decision was made to terminate Credit Customer Policy effective 01.07.2023
 - ❖ No instant clearance on guaranteed invoices
 - ❖ Instant payments before delivery of consignments
 - ❖ Bank operational hours complicated instant payment requirement
- ❑ Business situation forced in the need for processing Customer Advances/Deposits
 - ❖ Lack of system features meant Customer deposits & informs Credit Control
 - ❖ Customer later informs Credit Control on clearances to be executed
 - ❖ Information channels (email, calls & visits) slowed clearance process & crowded Credit Control Offices
 - ❖ Customers lost use of Self-Service facilities



Solution

- ❑ The KPA Banks were invited to help solve this problem using various bank tools: -
 - ❖ NBK was first to respond with the E-Wallet – the solution was for the Ferry Toll Charge so did not fit our requirements
 - ❖ Citibank came with a solution – primarily a receivables reconciliation solution
 - ❖ NBK came again with a solution that was incomplete
 - ❖ Stanbic came with the closest solution to our requirements
- ❑ We developed the Stanbic proposal to what we today call **KARGO PAY**
 - ❖ Customer Self-Service – Advances/Deposit
 - ❖ 24/7 - Banking and off-Banking hours (No amount limits)
 - ❖ 95% Port processes – Bank only load & host e-wallet
 - ❖ Maintenance by Credit Control

❑ Banks integration for online payments

- ✓ Pesa-link processing of huge (unlimited) inter-Bank payments outside of the official bank working hours.
- ✓ RTGS processing during official working hours for both **USD** & KES
- ✓ Instant collections – use of Bank Debit/Credit Cards, Regional Mobile Money, onto the Kargo Pay eWallet

❑ Streamlined processes

- ✓ Manual management of Customer deposits

❑ Extension of consignment information to Consignees

- ✓ Provide platform for Port Community integrations with the Partner State Revenue Authorities & other PGAs for single point of information

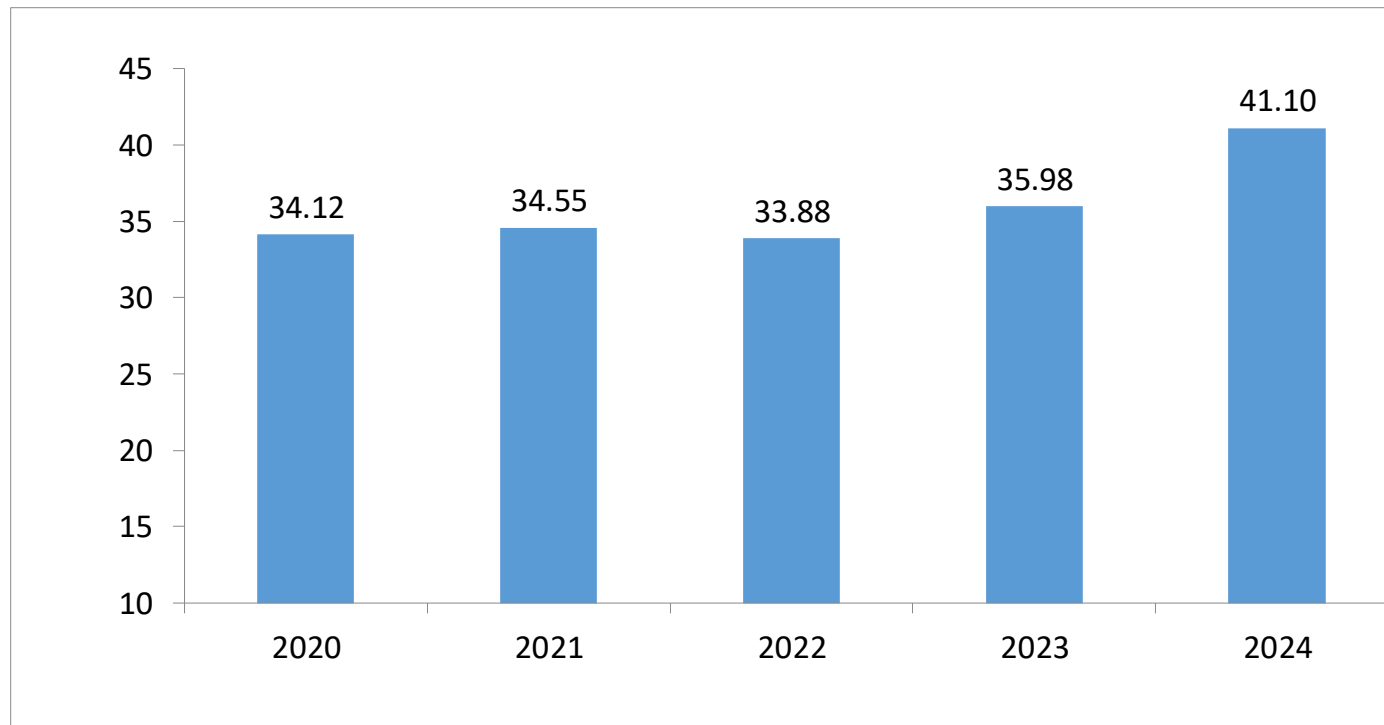

Port Throughput (MT '000''): 2020 – 2024

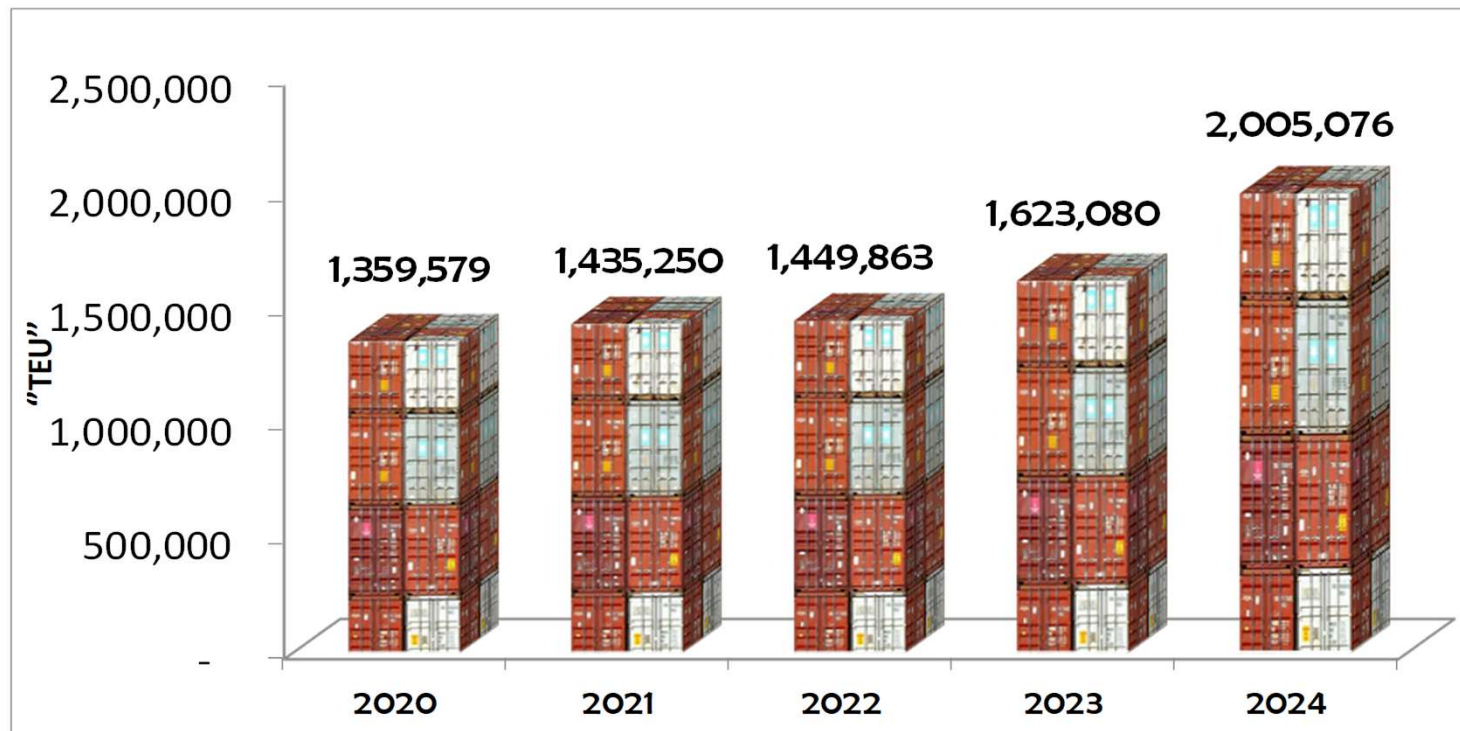


Rate of increase for the period: 4.7%

Container Traffic (TEU): 2020 - 2024

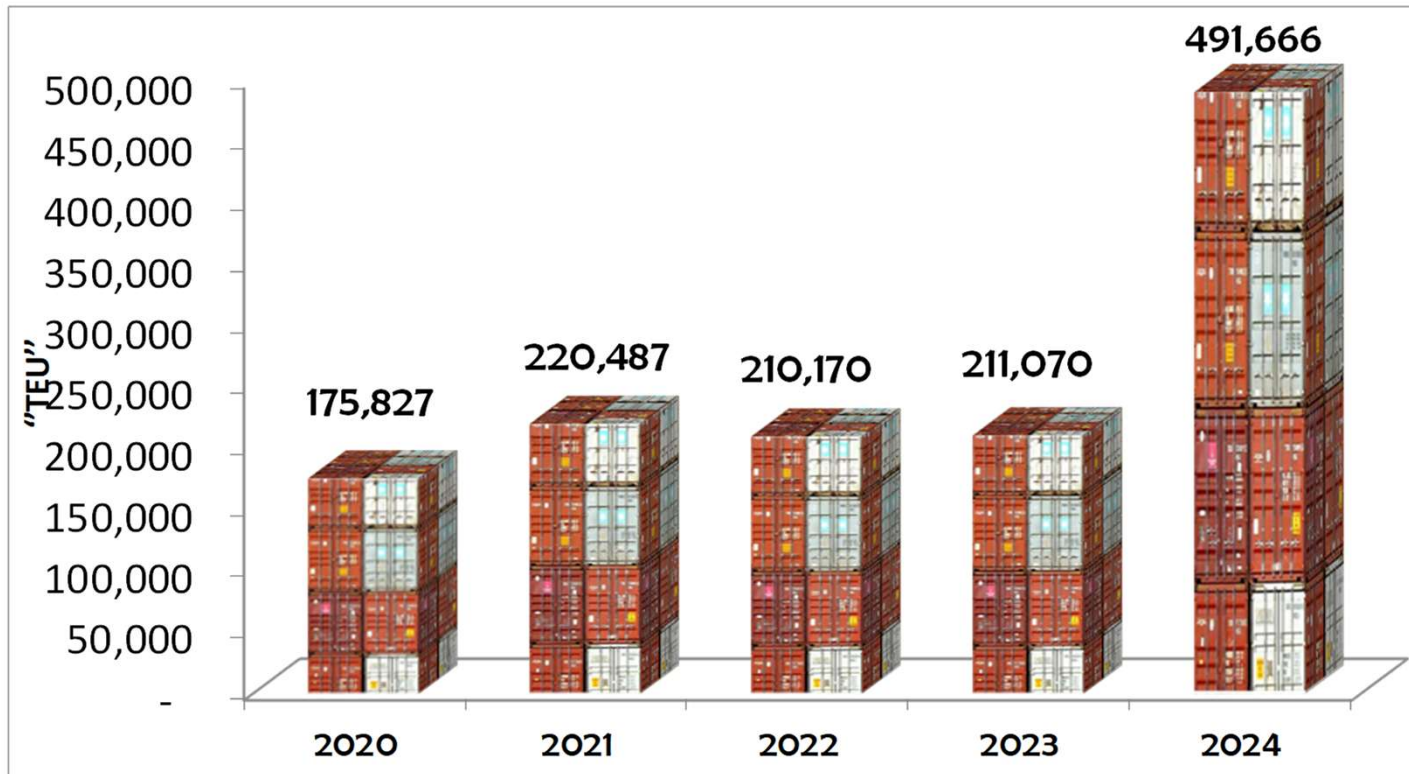


Rate of increase for the period: 10.2%

Transshipment Traffic (TEU): 2020 - 2024

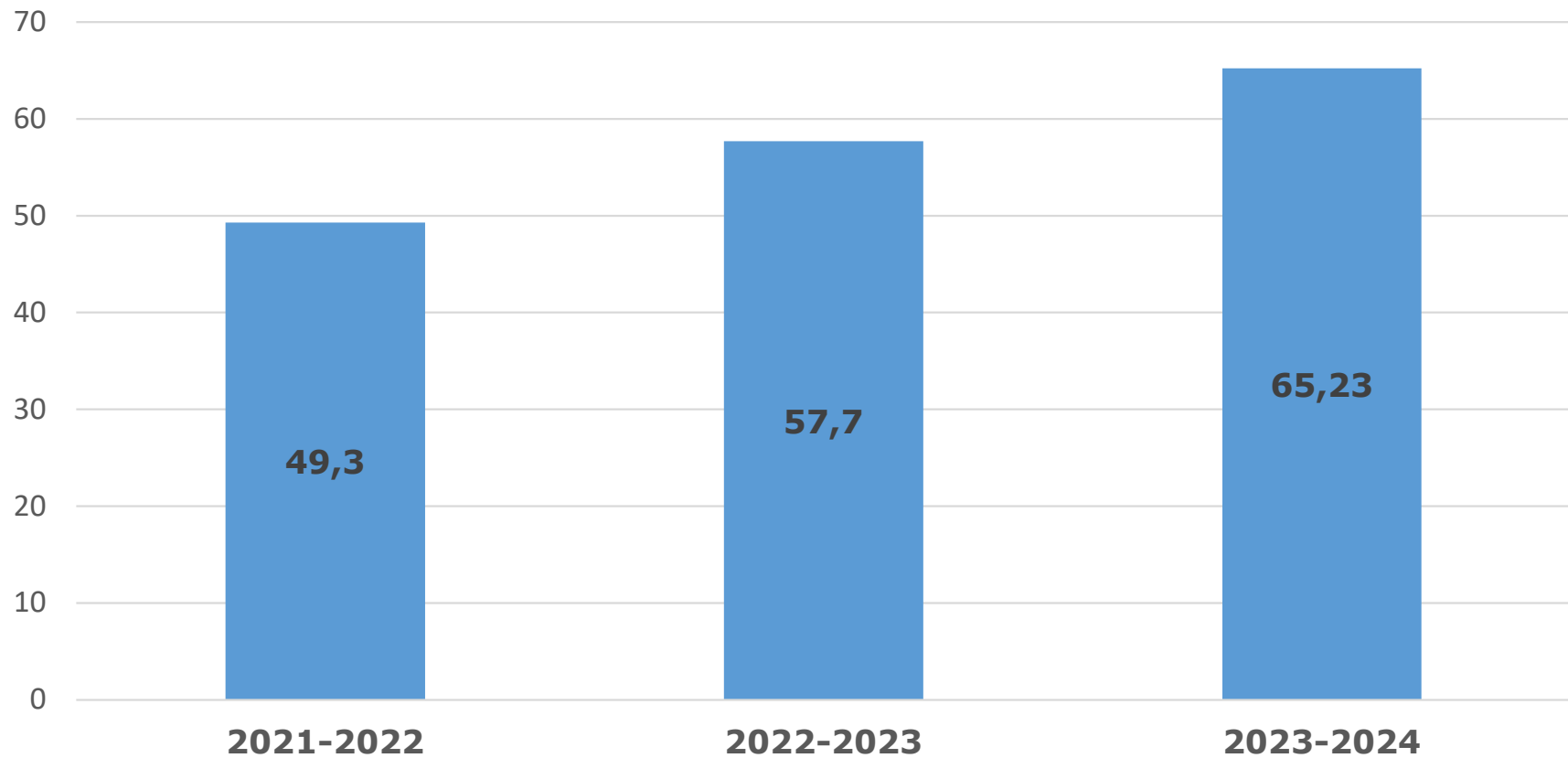


Rate of increase for the period: 29.3%



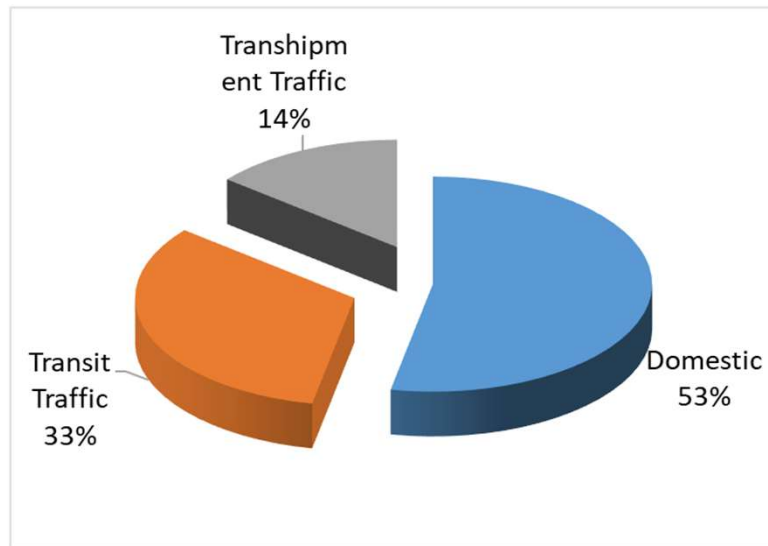

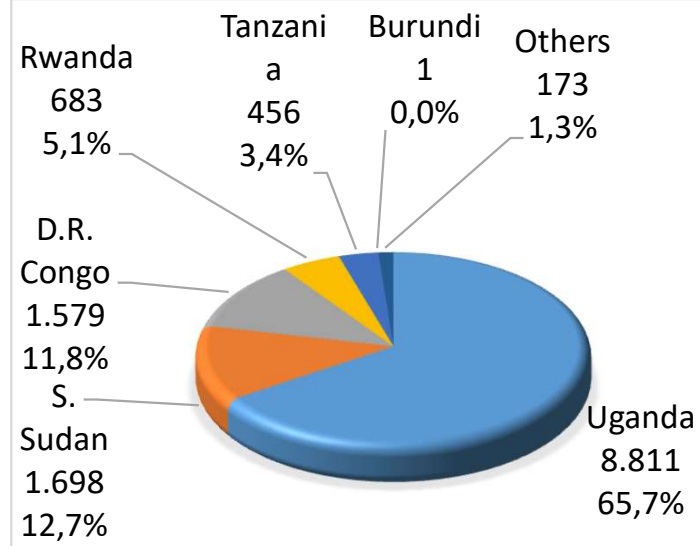

Market Segmentation 2024

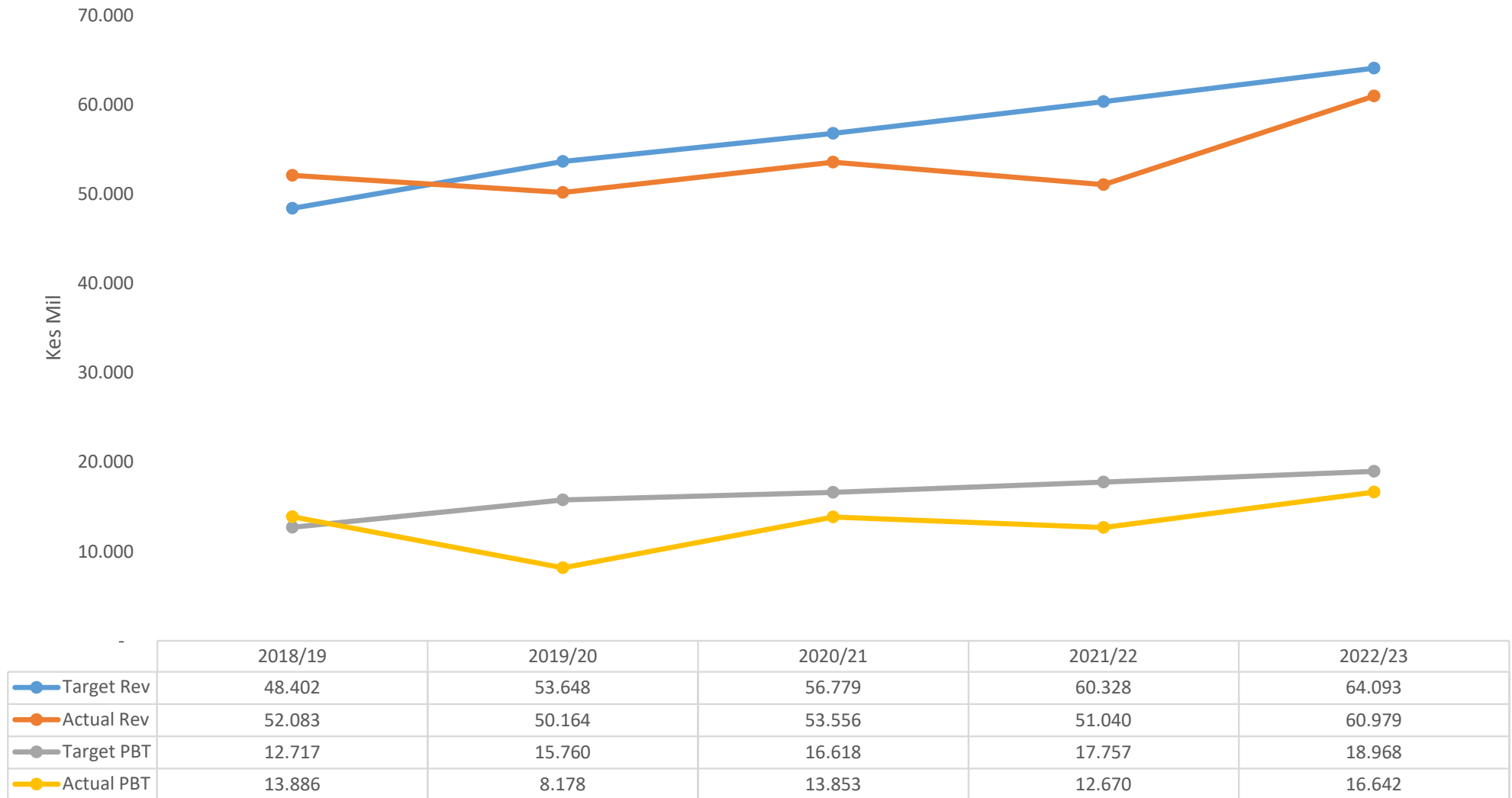


Transit Market Share 2024



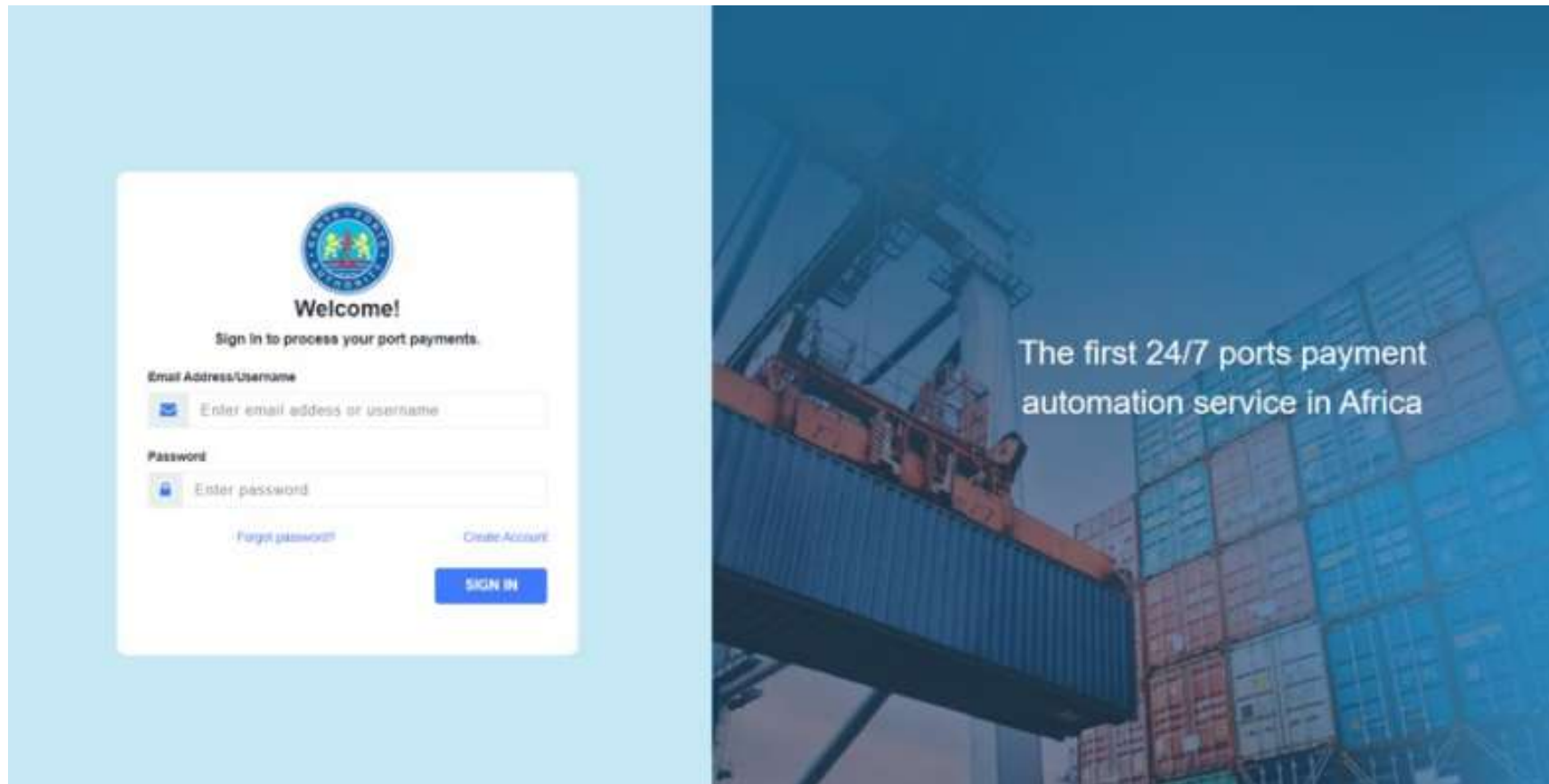
Financial Indicators: Revenue and Profit Before Tax

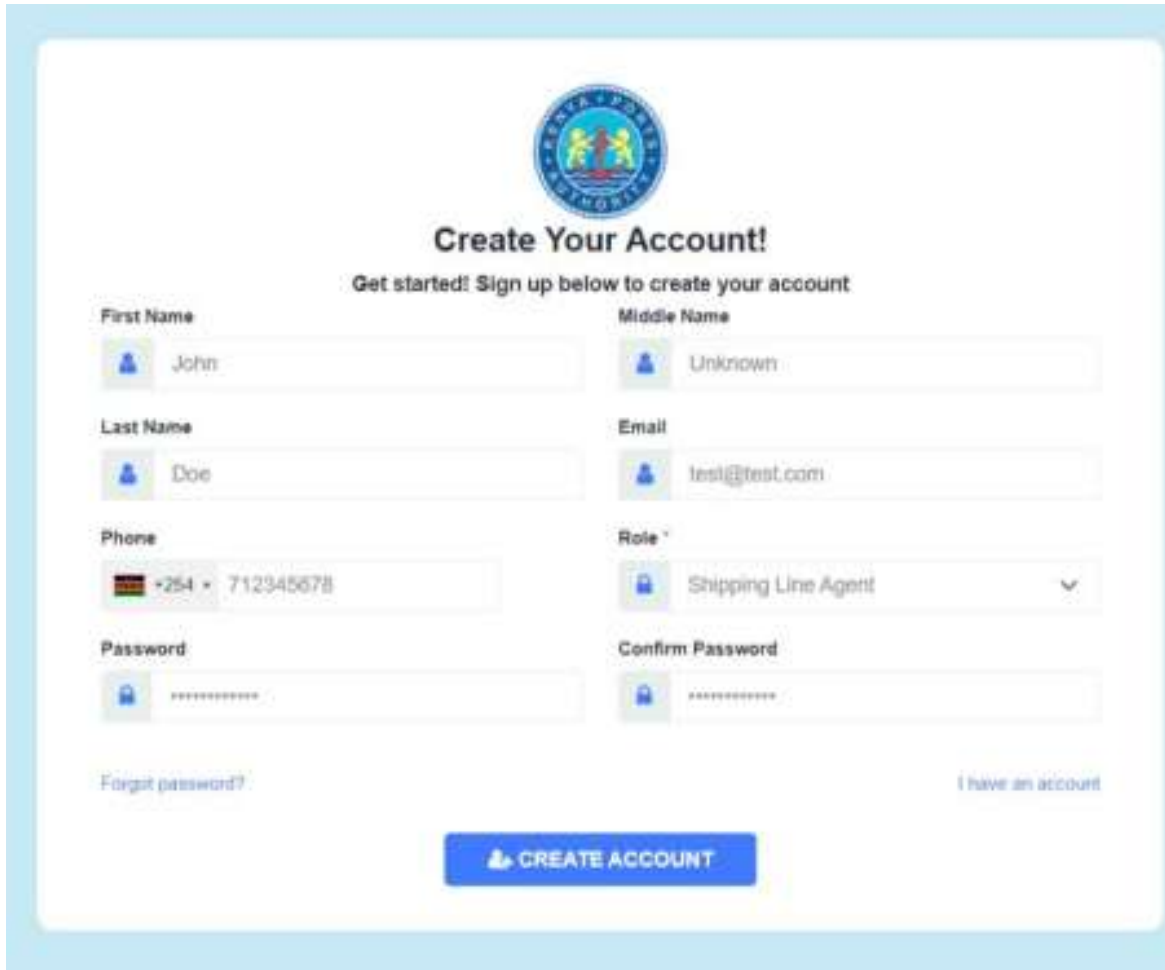

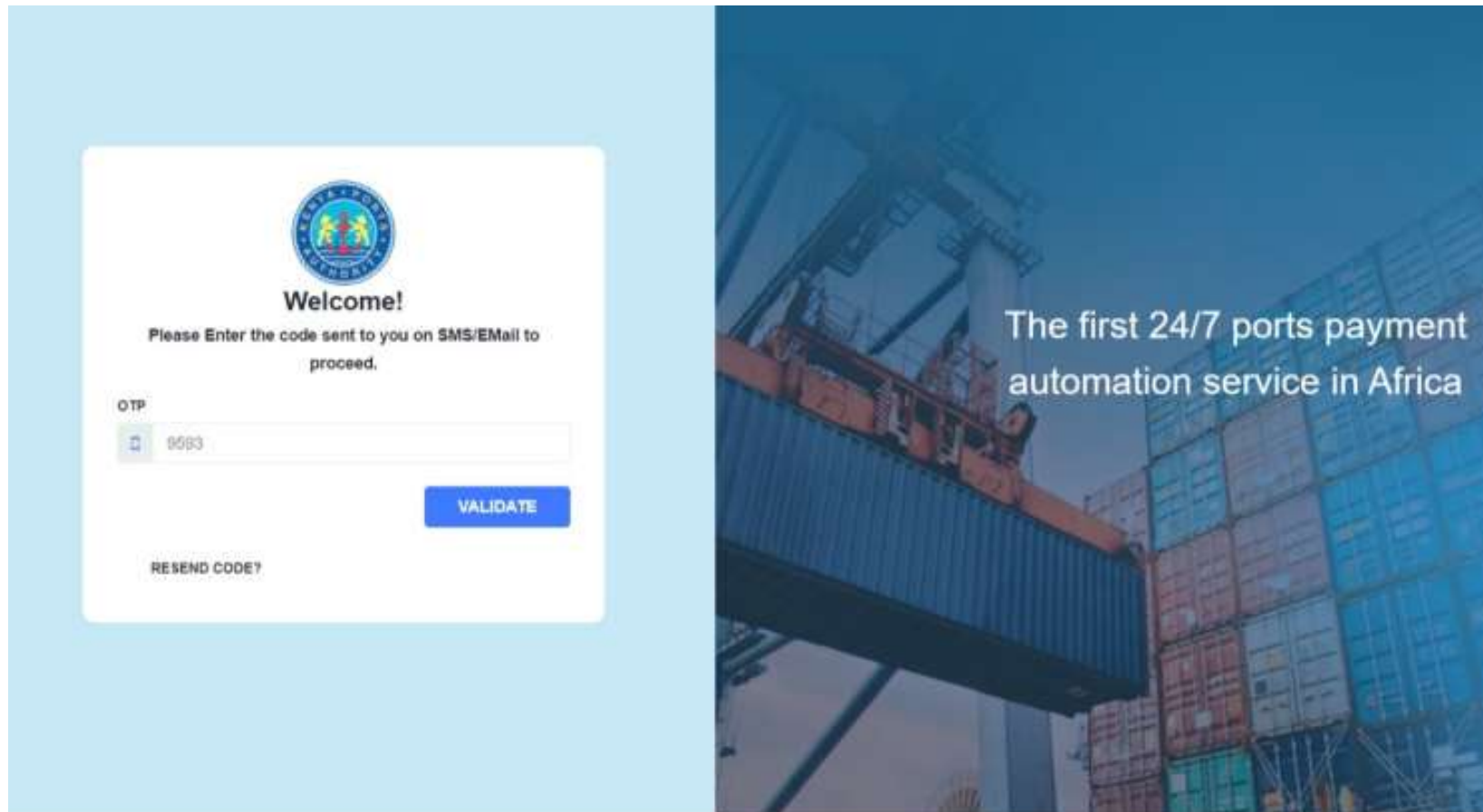
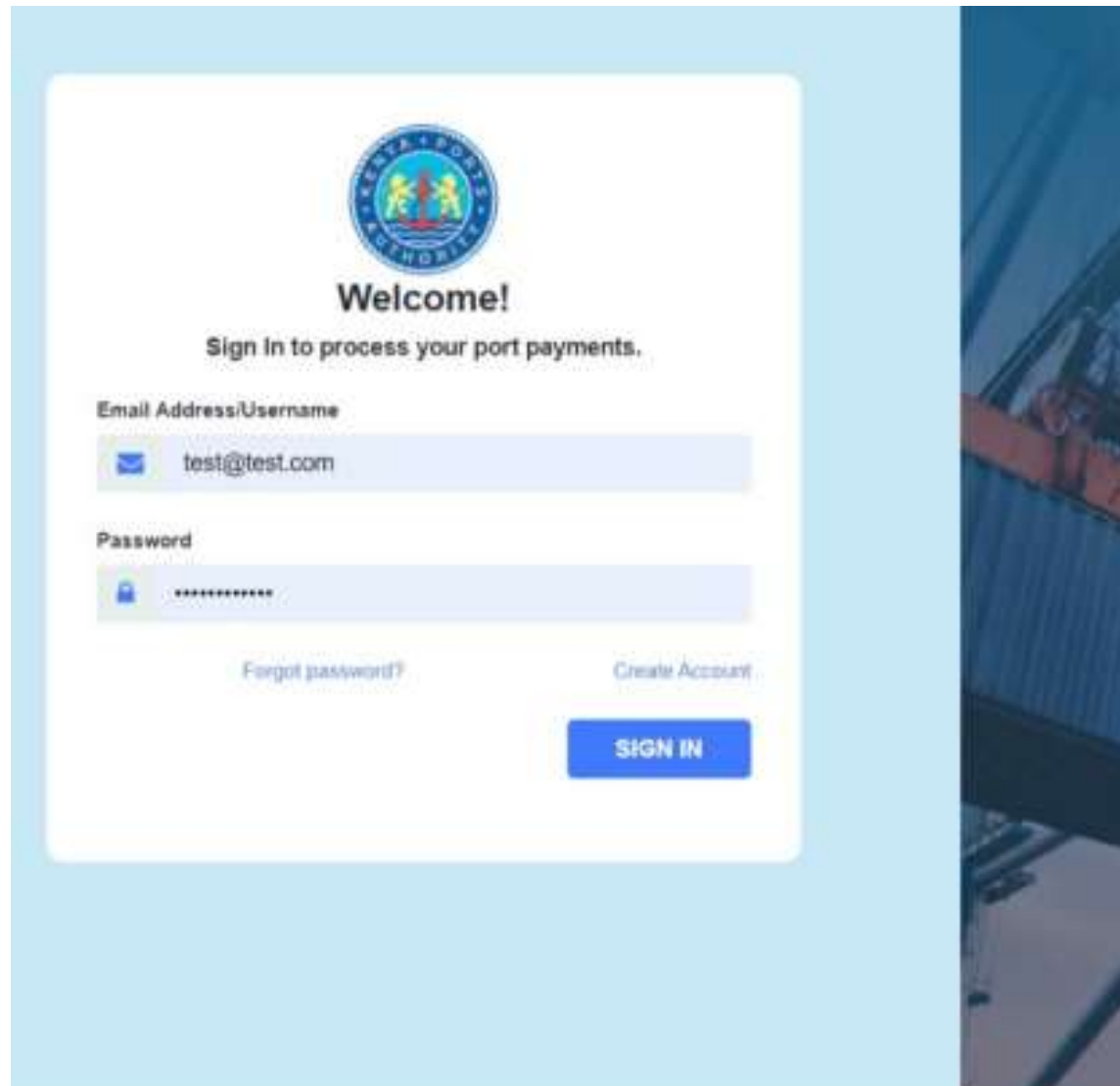


Figure 3: OTP Screen
